"THIS PLAY EXPLORES AGE APPROPRIATE THEMES AND MOMENTS OF EMOTIONAL AND PHYSICAL INTIMACY/VULNERABILITY (I.E. ROMANTIC RELATIONSHIPS, LOVE, MARRIAGE, ETC.) STUDENTS WILL NEVER BE ASKED TO DO ANYTHING WITH WHICH THEY FEEL UNCOMFORTABLE. ALL STUDENTS WILL BE ASKED TO HELP DEVELOP CREATIVE WAYS TO PORTRAY THESE MOMENTS AND THEMES WHILE RESPECTING EACH STUDENT'S INDIVIDUAL PHYSICAL AND EMOTIONAL BOUNDARIES. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO MAINTAIN AND SAFE AND JUDGEMENT FREE REHEARSAL ENVIRONMENT BY REFRAINING FROM INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR (I.E. LAUGHING, POINTING, SIDE COMMENTS, MAKING FUN, ETC.)"
